



Ralph & Gladys Borden Memorial Scholarship Application

The scholarship will be presented each year to a graduating senior who resides in the former New Market School. The scholarship is renewable for up to eight semesters based on the students continued college performance and funds available from the endowment left by the estate of Ralph Borden.

The following guidelines will be used in making the scholarship selection:

1. The recipient shall be a graduating senior living within the former New Market School District. The recipient may use said scholarship toward participation in any diploma program which includes vocational-technical training or full time studies in a college, university or trade school.
2. Financial need of the recipient shall be considered.
3. Students should provide a list of achievements, honors, elected positions, and volunteer/service experiences.
4. Special consideration will be given to students who are involved in extracurricular activities and volunteer work.
5. The selection committee shall disburse the scholarship grant to the post high school institution designated by the recipient.
6. The selection committee shall reserve the right to not award the scholarship should they determine that no applicant is worthy.
7. The scholarship shall be awarded without regard to race, color, creed, gender, national original or physical handicap.
