

Clarinda Police Department – Fatal Vision Project

The Clarinda Police Department is pleased to announce the recent addition of “Fatal Vision” equipment to the department’s inventory thanks to a generous donation in the amount of \$1,700 from the Clarinda Foundation and support from the City of Clarinda budget. Chief Keith Brothers states the Fatal Vision equipment will greatly enhance the department’s community policing vision and philosophy. Fatal Vision is a program developed by nationally renowned public safety material provider Innocorp that utilizes virtual reality to show the dangers of driving while impaired while under the influence of alcohol and/or drugs. Brothers unveiled the program Tuesday evening, March 1st at the Clarinda Lion’s Club meeting held at J’s Pizza and Steakhouse. Brothers stated that the “Fatal Vision” program is adaptable to any group that requests a demonstration such as youth groups, civic organizations, school clubs, and faith based organizations, workplace settings, etc. Brothers concluded by saying this project would not have been possible without the support of the Clarinda Foundation.
